



Who: Christ Community Church is a non-denominational, Bible based church. Lyla Madden started the pantry approximately 30 years ago. When it was first started it was very small and run out of a kitchen pantry closet.

Recently, a building was built for the pantry by Christ Community Church, giving us room for more food. Anyone is welcome to use the pantry. Recipients will be asked to complete a registration form and will need to provide picture ID, and proof of address.

What: Typically, 5-6 pounds of frozen items such as meat, pizza, prepared dinners, refrigerated items such as milk, cheese, and eggs, and non-perishable dry goods such as cereal, canned soup, noodles, canned vegetables, and personal care items, paper products, and condiments.
