Who: The Community Center of Hope serves people primarily from Southern Marathon County, from Edgar to Bevent and everything in between. Anyone is welcome to come and use the pantry. The Community Center of Hope serves about 200-250 people each month currently (March 2022). Pre-COVID, around 400-450 people used the pantry each month.

What: On Tuesdays and Thursdays the pantry is open to people who need to stock their shelves. Food items that are available to pick up are non-perishables, meat, dairy, deli and bakery. They also provide cat and dog food also from the Pet Ministry. Eligibility requirements to use the pantry are currently waived due to COVID-19 pandemic, as of March 2022. When: The Community Center of Hope is open for client hours from 2:30pm-4:50pm on Tuesdays, and 9am-11am on Thursdays.

Additional Information: Due to COVID-19, clients must be masked regardless of vaccination status. The mask must cover both nose and mouth and if you do not have one, we will provide one when available. Space in the pantry is at a limited capacity, so please wait in your vehicle, or if there is a designated parking space available please grab a cart and come inside! One individual per household is allowed into the pantry at a time.
